### **Elim – The Third Stopping Place: Surrender**

*And said, If thou wilt diligently hearken to the voice of the LORD thy God, and wilt do that which is right in his sight, and wilt give ear to his commandments, and keep all his statutes, I will put none of these diseases upon thee, which I have brought upon the Egyptians: for I am the LORD that healeth thee. 27Then they came to Elim, where there were twelve wells of water and seventy palm trees; so they camped there by the waters. Exodus 15:26-27*

Soon after leaving Marah, the cloud by day and the pillar of fire by night that guided the Israelites came to rest at Elim, which means a *strong palm tree*. Once again God halted their journey. This stopping place drew its name from the seventy strong, healthy palm trees that grew amidst twelve wells in the desert! After the experience of Marah where the Israelites cried out for water, this oasis was most refreshing! From this stop onward, their success and survival would depend upon their absolute surrender to God!
